APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Ted Berreth (Name of applicant) of Box 706 Ontario (Postoffice), county of Malheur state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Snake River (Name of stream) tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .5 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigate 5 Acre Tract

4. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located well drilled in 1948 64 1/2 ft. North and 63 ft. west of E 1/4 Corner of Sec. 7, Twp 18 S. R. 47 E.W.M. (Give distance and bearing from section corner)

being within the N 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 7, Twp. 18 S, R. 47 E, W. M., in the county of Malheur

5. The (Canal or pipe line) to be miles in length, terminating in the (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. of Twp. R., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Berreth # 1

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of One Well (Give number of wells, tunnels, etc) having a diameter of 12 inches and an estimated depth of 35 feet.

PERMIT

I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, with the following limitations and conditions:

The water herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.063 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A Well

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be so cased as to prevent the loss of underground water.

The priority date of this permit is April 25, 1952

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1953 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1954

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1955
