APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

# To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through Department of the Army, Corps  
(Name of applicant)  
of Engineers, City-County Airport, Walla Walla, county of Walla Walla,  
state of Washington, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

2. The amount of water which the applicant desires to apply to beneficial use is 3.45 cubic  
feet per second.

Dam and McNary Townsite.

1385 feet on a bearing of N 10° - 59' W from Section Corner 10, 11, 15, 14

Remarks: This well is to be used for emergency standby for existing McNary Well No. 2 with a developed capacity of 5.35 cfs (2400 gpm) and will be used solely for domestic and industrial use. No irrigation will be permitted when this well is in operation as all water will be required for McNary Dam Powerhouse.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.45 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well (Well No. 3)

The use to which this water is to be applied is Municipal (all of the purposes for which water could be used in a city under a right initiated for municipal use)

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be so cased as to prevent the loss of underground water.

The priority date of this permit is February 5, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
