# To Appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, We, J. J. Ohlegschlager and Mary E. Ohlegschlager  
(Name of applicant)  
of R. F. D. 3,  
(Postoffice), county of Wasco,  
state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate  
the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development  
is situated Chenowith  
(Name of stream)

tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .05  
cubic feet per second, for the irrigation of 5 acres.

3. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located 60' S and 283' W  
of the NE corner of NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 32 Twp. 2 N. R. 13 E.  
(Give distance and bearing from section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 E 1/2 of Tract 3 of Sec. 32, Twp. 2 N, R. 13 E,  
W. M., in the county of Wasco

4. The pipe line to be 500 feet miles  
(Canal or pipe line) Park Tracts  
in length, terminating in the E 1/2 of Tract 3 of Mission of Sec. 32, Twp. 2 N,  
(Smallest legal subdivision) R. 13 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

5. The name of the well or other works is Ohlegschlager Irrigation System

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

6. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of  
the supply when not in use must be described.

7. The development will consist of one well having a  
(Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.)  
diameter of six inches and an estimated depth of 140 feet.

8. A description of the pipe lines, canals or other distributing works is as follows: Diameter of pipe 1 1/2 inches, length 500 feet, kind galvanized  
(Wood, cast iron, wrought, concrete)  
Difference in elevation between ground surface at well and discharge end of pipe, three feet  
feet. If canal used in addition to pipe, give description. Width on top (at water line) \_\_\_\_\_  
feet; width on bottom \_\_\_\_\_ feet; depth of water \_\_\_\_\_ feet; grade \_\_\_\_\_ feet  
fall per 1,000 feet.

9. If pumps are to be used, give size and type size of pump will be determined after well has  
been constructed.

10. If the location of the well, tunnel, or other development work is less than one-fourth mile  
from a natural stream or stream channel, give the distance to the nearest point on each of such channels  
and the difference in elevation between the stream bed and the ground surface at the source of  
development This well will be located approximately one and one-half miles from  
Chenowith Creek.

11. The land to be irrigated has a total area of 5 acres, located in each smallest legal  
subdivision, as follows: 2.8 Acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 1.4 Acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and 0.8 acre in  
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sect. 32, Twp. 2 N., R. 13 E., W. M.

12. Estimated cost of proposed works, \$ 1200.00

13. Development work will begin on or before May 12, 1931

14. Development work will be completed on or before August 30, 1931

15. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Sept. 30, 1931

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer

.....The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of 0.05  
.....second-foot of water from a well located in the NW<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup> Sec. 32,  
.....Tp. 2 N. R. 13 E. W. M. for irrigation of 5 acres.....

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1/80th cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 13, 1931

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 15, 1932 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1933

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1934
