Remarks: The description of the land being acquired by Roy Gail Holzappel, is the South half of Section 32, T. 4 N., R. 27 E.W.M. It seems best to not place an initial point close to the proposed location of the well or irrigated land, as it would be difficult to find and could easily be destroyed by future tilling of the land, which can be practically all farmed. The Southwest corner of Section 32, is well marked by U. S. Land Survey corner. An iron pipe, 2" diameter, with bronze cap and can be found at a fence corner. It will not be difficult to survey from this point, the country being nearly level and open.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.613 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from The Holzapfel Wells (2 wells).

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The well shall be so cased as to prevent the loss of underground water.

The priority date of this permit is March 16, 1953

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
