

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, O. G. Luehrs (Name of applicant) of Ontario (Postoffice), county of Malheur, state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation not corporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Malheur and Snake Rivers (Name of stream) tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second, for the irrigation of 20 acres

The portion of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, of Section 4, Twp. 18 South, Range 47 E. W.M. described as follows: Beginning at the Quarter section corner between sections 4 and 5, Twp. 18, Range 47, E. W. M., thence North 20 ft.; thence East 20 ft. distant from and parallel to the half section line of Section 4. 1381.1 ft. to a point, begin the point of beginning, thence East along a prolongation of the aforesaid line 577.5 ft.; thence North 223 ft.; thence East 229 ft.; thence North 28° 32' E-275.15 ft.; thence North 0°-56' W-188.5 ft.; thence North 89°56' W-644.1 ft.; thence South 6° 49' E. 70 ft.; thence South 9° 43' W-47 ft.; thence South 62° 12' W-111 ft.; thence South 13° 43' W-233.3 ft.; thence South 33° 10' W-48 ft.; thence South 60° 13' W-104 ft.; thence South 7° 14' W-168.9 ft.; to the point of beginning, containing 9.63 acres.

South one-half of the North one-half of the South East one-fourth of the North West one-fourth, Section Four. Township Eighteen South, Range Forty-seven E.W.M. in Malheur County, Oregon, containing ten acres together with five shares of the capital stock of the Owyhee Ditch Co. of the par value of ten dollars per share.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

6. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

Not artesian

7. The development will consist of one well having a diameter of 5 feet inches and an estimated depth of 40 feet.

8. Supplementary.

There is a 10 inch pipe line (concrete) running from the well west about 150 feet which empties into ditch No. 1.

Ditch #1.

About 2 feet wide at the top, 18 inches wide at the bottom and about 300 feet long which flows north and terminates at about 150 east of the NW corner of SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4 in said Twp and Range, with a fall for approximately 1 foot to 1000 feet. The land is irrigated by means of laterals both to the east and the west of this ditch.

Ditch #2

About 2 feet wide at the top, 18 inches at the bottom and about 330 feet long running north from the well and terminates about 200 feet west of the NE corner of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4 said Twp. and Range, having a fall of about 1 foot to the 1000 feet. The land is irrigated to the east, except, about two acres around house and barn, by means of laterals.

Ditch #3

About 2 feet wide at the top, 18 inches at the bottom and about 660 feet long running in a southerly direction west with a fall of about 1 foot to the 1000 feet, and terminating about 100 feet east of the SW corner of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4 in said Twp and Range. This irrigates the land to the east upon the irregular tract of land described herein.

These ditches are controlled from a box at the well in which gates are placed to direct the flow of the water.

- 12. Estimated cost of proposed works, \$ 1500.00
- 13. Development work will begin on or before at once
- 14. Development work will be completed on or before October 1st, 1931
- 15. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before August 1, 1931

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer

..... The right herein is limited to the appropriation of 0.25 second-feet of water
..... from a well located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 4, T. 18 S. R. 47 E.W.M.
..... for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1/80th cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 22, 1931

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 15, 1932 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
Oct. 1, 1933

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
Oct. 1, 1934
