2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3.25 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation.

4. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section two (2) in Township thirty-eight (38),
(Give distance and bearing from section corner)
south of Range eleven and one half (11 1/2), East of the Willamette Meridian, the exact location to be shown on map to be made. Well has not been drilled and its exact location is yet unknown, being within the tract above described.

~~Work~~ in the county of Klamath, State of Oregon.

5. The main ditch or canal to be one and 1/2 miles in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, Twp. 38, S. R. 11 1/2 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map, to be supplied.

6. The name of the well or other works is Angel Well No. 1.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described. Not applicable.

8. The development will consist of one well, ditches and pump, -well having a diameter of 16 inches and an estimated depth of up to 600 feet.
(Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.)
Well has not yet been drilled and its depth is unknown, though it is hoped to get sufficient water at less than 600 feet.

AMENDMENTS TO APPLICATION No. U-464-Jesse J. Angel, Jr. and wife-

Come now, Jesse J. Angel, Jr., and Jean Drew Angel, husband and wife, by and through their attorney, A.C. Yaden, applicants for well permit under Application No. U-464, for irrigation water and submit the following amendments to their said application, to-wit:

Amending item 2 on page 1 of said application the same is amended to show the amount of water to be applied to beneficial use is 3.26125 cubic feet per second instead of ~~3.25~~ 3.25. (It is believed that 3.26 will properly serve).

Amending item 4 on page 1 of said application the same is amended to read as follows: The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located north 64 degrees 34 minutes east, 1,394 feet from the one quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 11 of Township 38 South of Range 11 1/2 E.W.M., being within the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 2, in Township 38, South of Range 11 1/2 E.W.M. in Klamath County, Oregon.

Amending item 9(c) on page 2 of said application the figure 16 for pipe diameter is changed to 18 inches.

Amending item 11 on page 2 of said application the same is amended by deleting the following, "The well has not yet been drilled and its exact location is not yet known, but it will be within one quarter of a mile of the place where the permit is to be granted, the exact location will be supplied before issuance of permit", and inserting the following: "The proposed well will be more than one mile from any stream or stream channel."

Amending item 2 of said application, the same is amended to show the area to be irrigated, or place of use -----

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.261 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Angal Well No. 1

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; this permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions of a stipulation recorded on Pages 740-741, Volume 3, Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer and by reference made a part hereof,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be so cased as to prevent the loss of underground water.

The priority date of this permit is February 19, 1952 for 3.250 cfs September 30, 1953 for 3.250 cfs 0.011 cfs

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 20, 1954 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1955

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1956
