

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Chrisa Lee Estate of Baker county of Baker state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Sand Creek tributary of Powder River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2.2 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located S. 23°37'W., 3268 feet from the quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 28, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

being within the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 28 Twp. 7 S. R. 39 E. W. M., in the county of Baker

5. The Main ditch to be 2400 feet in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 28 Twp. 7 S. R. 39 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Lee Well

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of One well having a diameter of 12 inches and an estimated depth of 320 feet.

DESCRIPTION OF CHRIS LEE PROPERTY

The Southeast quarter of Section 21, the Northeast quarter of Section 28, that part of the Northwest quarter and the North half of the Southwest quarter of Section 28 which lies East of the Old Oregon Trail Highway U. S. #30; the Northwest quarter of Section 27 and the South half of Section 22, all in Township 7 South, Range 39 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

Excepting therefrom that portion of Section 28 above described, conveyed to Raymond T. O'Dell and Ethel E. O'Dell, husband and wife, by deed of record in Volume "141" Record of Deeds for Baker County, Oregon, at Page 260 thereof.

The following is the substance of the exception noted above, from Vol. 141, Page 260 of Records of Deeds:

PERMIT
I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.2 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Lea Well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation (supplemental)

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.2 c.f.s., provided further that the amount of water allowed herein together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be so cased so as to prevent the loss of underground water.
The priority date of this permit is March 17, 1954

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1955 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1956

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1957
