

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, George Haltenhoff (Name of applicant)  
of Route 4, The Dalles, county of Wasco,  
(Postoffice)  
state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate  
the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation not  
incorporated.

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development  
is situated Mill Cr. approximately 3/4 of a mile from proposed well  
(Name of stream)  
tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.14  
cubic feet per second, for the irrigation of 10.75 acres.

3. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located at the extreme northern  
part and about the center of Tract 9, Fruitland Park Addition to Dalles, Wasco County,  
(Give distance and bearing from section corner)  
Oregon

being within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 32, Twp. 2 N, R. 13 E,  
W. M., in the county of Wasco.

4. The pipe line to be about 725 feet ~~miles~~  
(Canal or pipe line)  
in length, terminating in the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 32, Twp. 2 N,  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
R. 13 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

5. The name of the well or other works is Haltenhoff irrigation system.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

6. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of  
the supply when not in use must be described.

7. The development will consist of one well having a  
(Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.)  
diameter of six inches and an estimated depth of 250 feet.

8. A description of the pipe lines, canals or other distributing works is as follows: Diameter of pipe 3 inches, length 725 feet, kind galvanized  
(Wood, cast iron, wrought, concrete)

If the location of the well, tunnel, or other development work is less than one-fourth mile from a natural stream or stream channel, give the distance to the nearest point on each of such channels and the difference in elevation between the stream bed and the ground surface at the source of development Well is located approximately 3/4 of a mile from Mill Creek.

11. The land to be irrigated has a total area of 10.75 acres, located in each smallest legal subdivision, as follows: acres being all of Tract 9 in Fruitland Park Addition to Dalles, Wasco County, Oregon and 5.75 acres being Lots 3, 4, 5, and 6 in Block 2, Mission Park Tracts Addition to Dalles City, Wasco County, Oregon. (8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  (2.75 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 32, T. 2 N. R. 13 E.

12. Estimated cost of proposed works, \$1500.00
13. Development work will begin on or before January 1, 1932
14. Development work will be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1933
15. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Oct. 1, 1934

From the plats it is impossible to locate exactly in which Section the said lands are located. The accompanied map is only an approximate location as to the Sections, Townships and Ranges.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer .....

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of 0.13 second-foot of water from a well located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 32, Twp. 2 N. R. 13 E.W.M. for irrigation purposes.....

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is October 31, 1931.....

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 31, 1932..... and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1933.....

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1934.....
