

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, We, Fred and Frances Williamson (Name of applicant)

of Tygh Valley (Postoffice), county of Wasco

state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated White River (Name of stream)

tributary of Deschutes

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/4 cubic feet per second, for the irrigation of 20 acres.

3. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located

being within the NE 1/4 Sec. 10, Twp. 4 S, R. 13 E, W. M., in the county of Wasco

If the location of the well, tunnel, or other development work is less than one-fourth mile from a natural stream or stream channel, give the distance to the nearest point on each of such channels and the difference in elevation between the stream bed and the ground surface at the source of development about 350 feet from shore line or bank of stream to well. Ground and surface at well about 12 feet above bed of stream

11. The land to be irrigated has a total area of .20 acres, located in each smallest legal subdivision, as follows: in NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 10

12. Estimated cost of proposed works, \$ 100.00

13. Development work will begin on or before March 1st, 1929

14. Development work will be completed on or before March 30th 1929

15. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before May 15th, 1929

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from a well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 10, Twp. 4 S., R. 13 E., W.M. for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is September 24, 1928

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1930 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1931

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1932
