APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Georgia Belle Holzappel (Name of applicant) of Wasco (Mailing address), county of Sherman, state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Butter Creek, approximately seven miles distant. (Name of stream) tributary of Columbia River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

4. The well or other source is located 1320 ft. S. (N. or S.) and 1320 ft. W. (E. or W.) from the NE corner of Section 32, T. 4 N., R. 27 E. W.M. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

If there is more than one well, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary. being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 32, Twp. 4 N., R. 27 E. W. M., in the county of MORROW

5. The pipe line (Canal or pipe line) to be 0.25 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 32, Twp. 4 N., R. 27 E. W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Holzappel Well No. 1

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described. well has been constructed and no artesian water was found.

8. The development will consist of one well (Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.) having a diameter of 12 inches and an estimated depth of 200 feet.

CANAL SYSTEM OR PIPE LINE—

10. If pumps are to be used, give size and type Worthington pump, 6", 9 5/8" bowl.

Give horsepower and type of motor or engine to be used 40 H. P. Electric motor.

11. If the location of the well, tunnel, or other development work is less than one-fourth mile from a natural stream or stream channel, give the distance to the nearest point on each of such channels and the difference in elevation between the stream bed and the ground surface at the source of development

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.225 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Holzappel Well No. 1

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be so cased as to prevent the loss of underground water.

The priority date of this permit is July 5, 1955

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 2, 1956 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1957

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1958
