Showing Proposed Pipe Line For H. E. Larsen

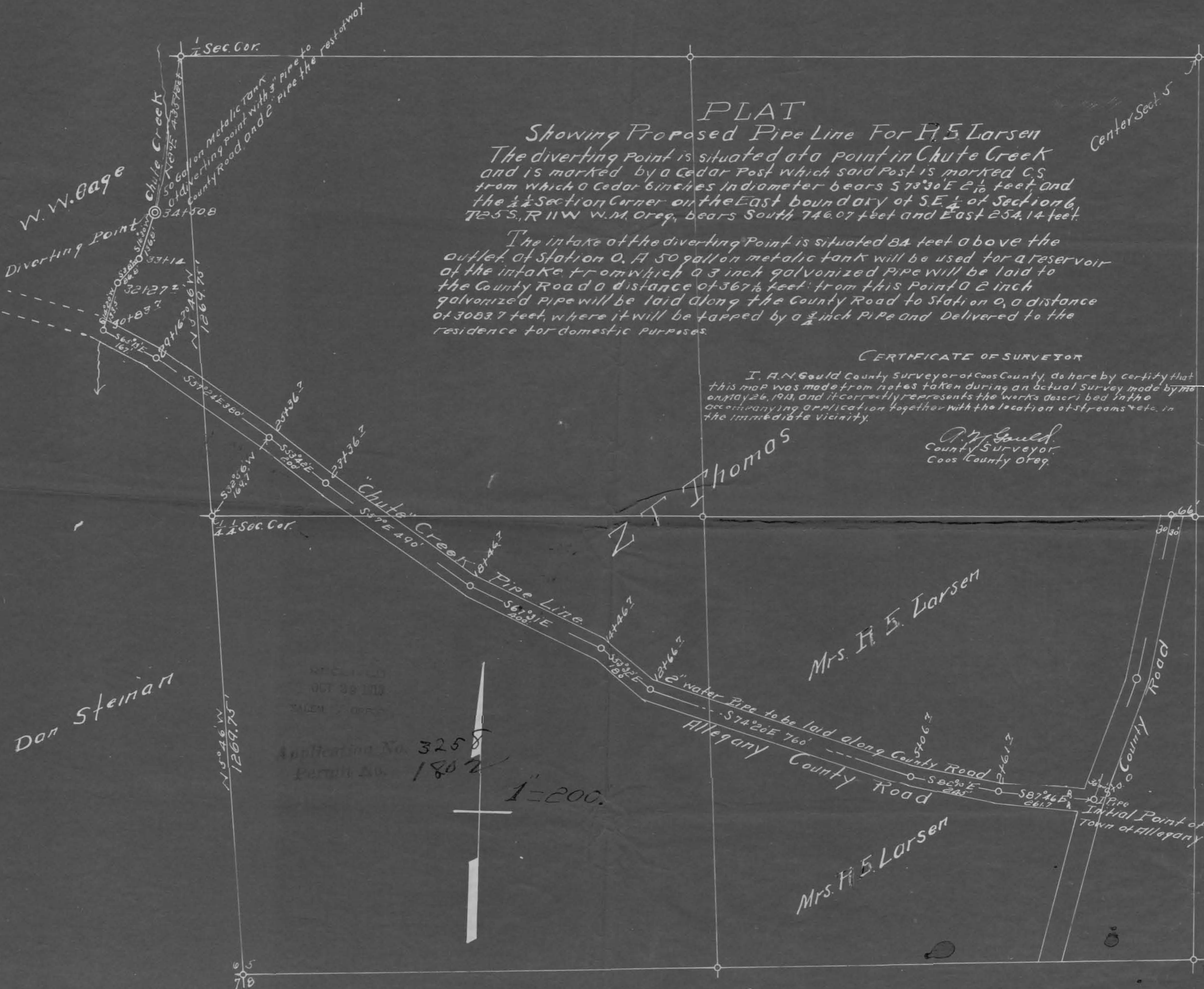
The diverting point is situated at a point in Chute Creek and is marked by a Cedar Post which said Post is marked C.S. from which a Cedar 6 inches in diameter bears $S73^{\circ}30'E$ $2\frac{1}{10}$ feet and the $\frac{1}{4}$ Section Corner on the East boundary of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, T25S., R11W W.M. Oreg., bears South 746.07 feet and East 254.14 feet.

The intake of the diverting point is situated 84 feet above the outlet of station 0. A 50 gallon metallic tank will be used for a reservoir of the intake, from which a 3 inch galvanized pipe will be laid to the County Road a distance of 367 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; from this point a 2 inch galvanized pipe will be laid along the County Road to station 0, a distance of 3083.7 feet, where it will be tapped by a $\frac{3}{4}$ inch pipe and delivered to the residence for domestic purposes.
