

## CERTIFICATE OF SURVEYOR.

Irving, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands delineated on the annexed plat, of which the following is a true and correct description: Beginning at a 2"x36" Galv. Iron Pipe, 2" above ground, and driven to solid rock, from which pipe the Exterior Ell Corner on the East boundary of the Jos. Cox D.L.C.N. #44, T27 S., R4 W., W.M. bears N 69° 12' 10" E 1516 1/2; Thence S 35° 16' E 10 1/2 to a point on the North boundary of Buckhorn Road; Thence following said boundary S 53° 57' 30" W 325 1/2 ft. to the beginning of a curve to the right, having a radius of 210 ft. and a central angle of 43° 14' 30"; Thence along said curve 158 1/2 ft. to the end thereof; Thence N 83° 48' W 995.47 ft. to the intersection of said North boundary with the East boundary of Strader Road; Thence N 25° 55' W 698 1/2 ft. along said East boundary; Thence S 78° 28' E 10 1/2 ft. to an axe, and 182 3/4 ft. to an axe; Thence S 47° 55' 40" E 263 9/8 ft. to an axe; Thence S 79° 16' 40" E 711 1/2 ft. to a 1/2" I.P., and 310 1/2 ft. to a 1/2" I.P., and 337 1/2 ft. to a 1/2" I.P.; Thence S 35° 16' E 156 1/2 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 21 1/2 Acres, more or less in Sections 20, and 21, T27 S., R4 W., W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.
