Marshall, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands represented on the annexed plat of PLAT 2 GOVERNMENT CAMP PARK; that as an initial point for said survey I planted a stone monument 8 x 10 x 14 inches, 6 inches below the surface of the ground, at a point which is 589°42'E 1398.26 feet and N0°14'E 740 feet from the southwest corner of Section 14, T.3 S.
