

NOTE - The initial point of the survey is the Section corner between Section 2 of Twp 10 SW and Section 3 of Twp 10 NW. The south boundary Avenue E is 30 feet south of said Section corner and runs going South from it will be on the center line of Central Avenue. One end of the Main Line is 30 feet North of the south boundary of Section 2 and is on the center line of Central Avenue, the other end is 300 feet North of the same Section corner running on the center line of Central Avenue.

All distances are measured along the center line of the streets. All measurements are given in feet and marked in red on the street lines on the north and west sides.



Know All Men by These Presents, That Glasgow Townsite Company, a Corporation duly incorporated and organized under the laws of the State and having its principal office at the City of Portland, in the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, doth by these presents establish and declare the aforesaid place to be the Plat of Glasgow.

Said Glasgow is situated on Lots Two (2) and Three (3) of Section Two (2) in Township Sixteen (16) Range Thirteen (13) West of the Willamette Meridian in the County of Coos, State of Oregon.

The initial point thereof is shown on said plat. Said initial point is the intersection of section corner between said Section Two (2) in said Township Sixteen (16) Range Thirteen (13) West of the Willamette Meridian and Section Two (2) in Township Twenty-Two (22) South of Range Thirteen (13) West of the Willamette Meridian in the County of Coos, State of Oregon.

Blocks One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20), Twenty-one (21), Twenty-two (22), Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24), Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), Twenty-seven (27), Twenty-eight (28), Twenty-nine (29), and Forty (40) are each one hundred and Fifty (50) feet East and West and Two Hundred feet North and South.

All other Blocks shown on said plat are Four hundred (400) feet East and West and Two hundred (200) feet North and South.

All Blocks are subdivided into Lots as shown on said plat. Each of said Lots are Twenty-five (25) feet East and West and One hundred (100) feet North and South.

All Blocks and Lots are numbered as shown on said plat.

Michigan Avenue and Central Avenue are each One hundred (100) feet wide. All other Avenues and Streets (with the exception of Avenue F, Tenth Court, Twelfth Court, Streets) are Eighty (80) feet wide. Avenue F, Tenth Court, Street (10th) and Twelfth Court Street, are each Forty (40) feet wide. There are no Avenues nor Streets in said Glasgow except as named, lettered or numbered on said plat. All said Avenues and Streets are hereby dedicated and granted to the Public use.

And the said Jonathan Bourne Jr. and the said George Holman being hereinafter first duly sworn did depose and say that the said Jonathan Bourne Jr. is the President and the said George Holman is the Secretary of the Glasgow Townsite Company, that they have made and caused to be made the foregoing instrument of writing and have caused and that the said Jonathan Bourne Jr. as president signed the same in the name of said Glasgow Townsite Company to the foregoing instrument of writing and that the said George Holman did attest the same and after thereunto the corporate seal of said Company in witness of the execution of the Board of Directors of said Company duly passed at regular meeting of said Board of Directors duly called and held on the sixth day of June A.D. 1890.


