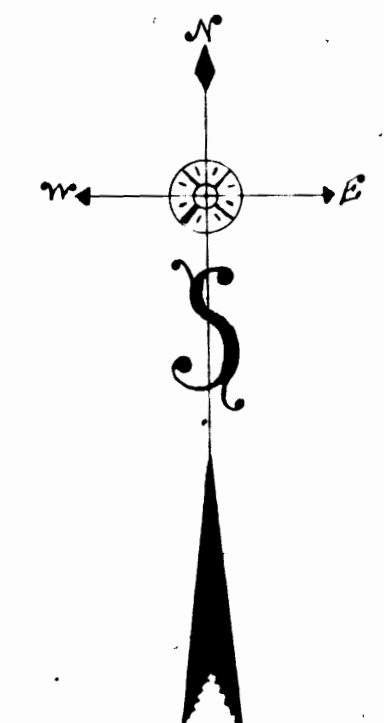

## AFFIDAVIT

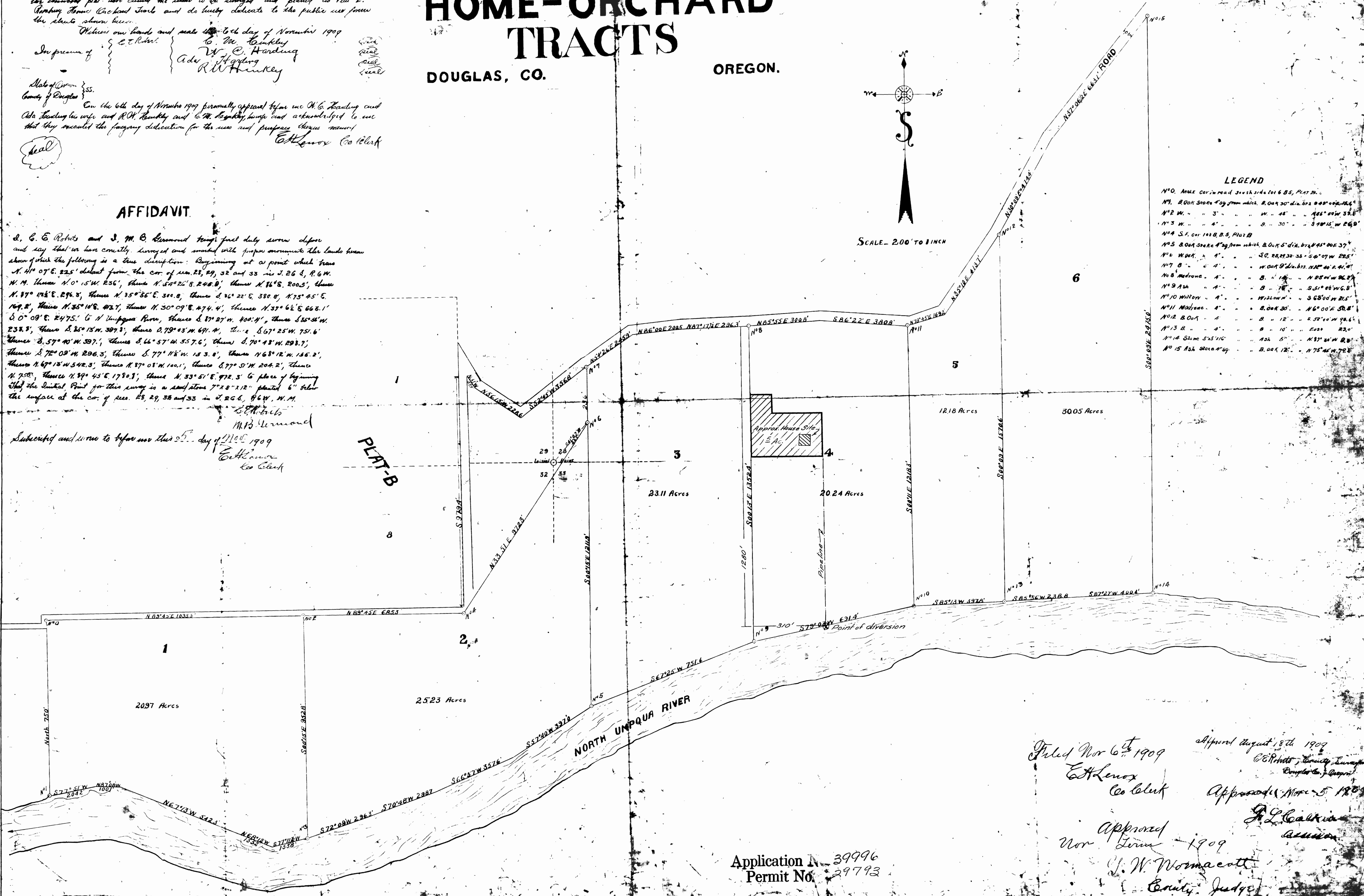
