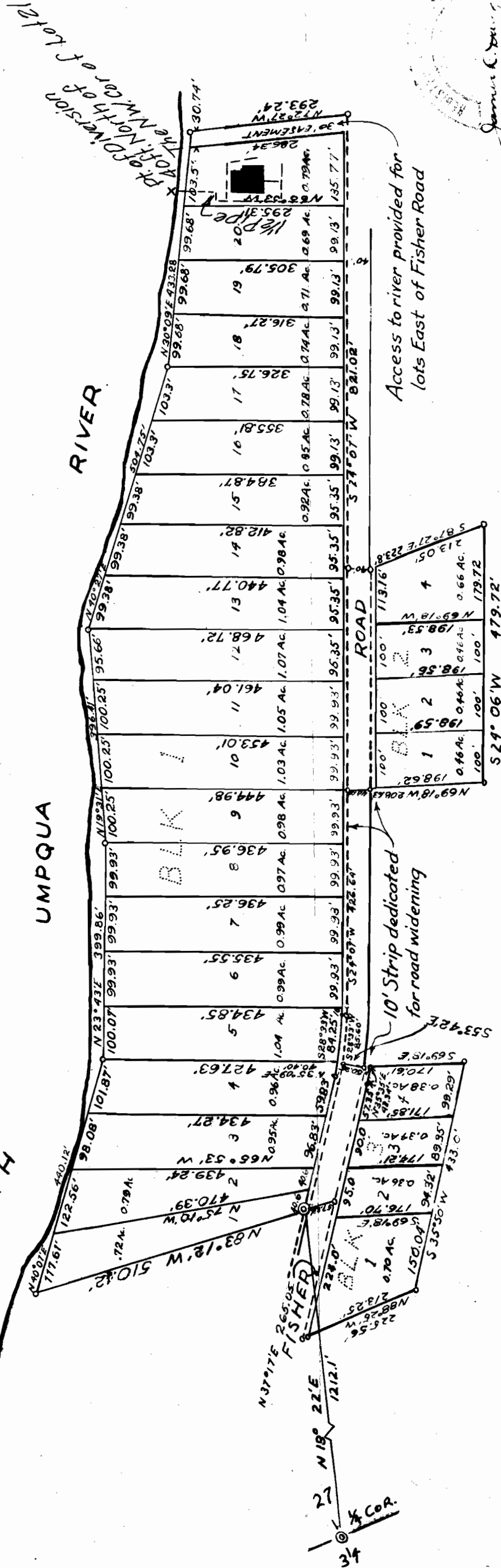


JOHN J. THENNES GROVE

ENGINEER'S CERTIFICATE

I, JAMES R. DAUGHERTY, being first duly sworn depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands delineated on the annexed plat of which the following is a true and correct description: Beginning at a 2"x36" Galv. Iron Pipe driven to 6" below ground, from which the 1/4 Corner between Secs. 27 and 34, T.26 S., R.6 W., W.M. bears S 16° 22' W 121.1 ft.; thence N 63° 12' W 510.12 ft. to an iron pipe on the East bank of the North Umpqua River; thence along said river as follows: N 40° 07' E 440.12 ft., N 23° 43' E 399.86 ft., N 19° 31' E 396.41 ft., N 40° 27' E 504.75 ft., N 30° 09' E 433.28 ft., thence S 72° 27' E 293.24 ft. to an iron rod on the Western Right-of-Way line of the Fisher Road; thence along said Fisher Road S 65° 53' E 90.0 ft. to an iron rod; thence S 87° 27' E 223.8 ft. to an iron rod; thence S 24° 06' W 479.72 ft. to an iron rod; thence N 69° 18' W 208.63 ft. to an iron rod on the Easterly R-W line of said road, and 40.07 ft. farther across said road to an iron rod; thence S 24° 07' W 426.64 ft. to an iron rod; thence around a 10" C.R. S 28° 33' W 85.60 ft. to an iron rod; thence across said Fisher Road S 02° 55' E 53.42 ft. to an I.R.; thence S 69° 18' E 170.61 ft. to an iron rod; thence S 35° 50' W 433.0 ft. to an iron rod; thence N 88° 25' W 225.56 ft. to an iron rod on the Easterly R-W line of said Fisher Road; thence N 37° 17' E 265.05 ft. to an iron rod; thence N 83° 12' W 46.67 ft. across said road to an iron rod, and 11.16 ft. farther to the place of beginning, containing within said boundaries an area of 2.332 Acres more or less.

Excepting therefrom: Fisher Road as located.
