

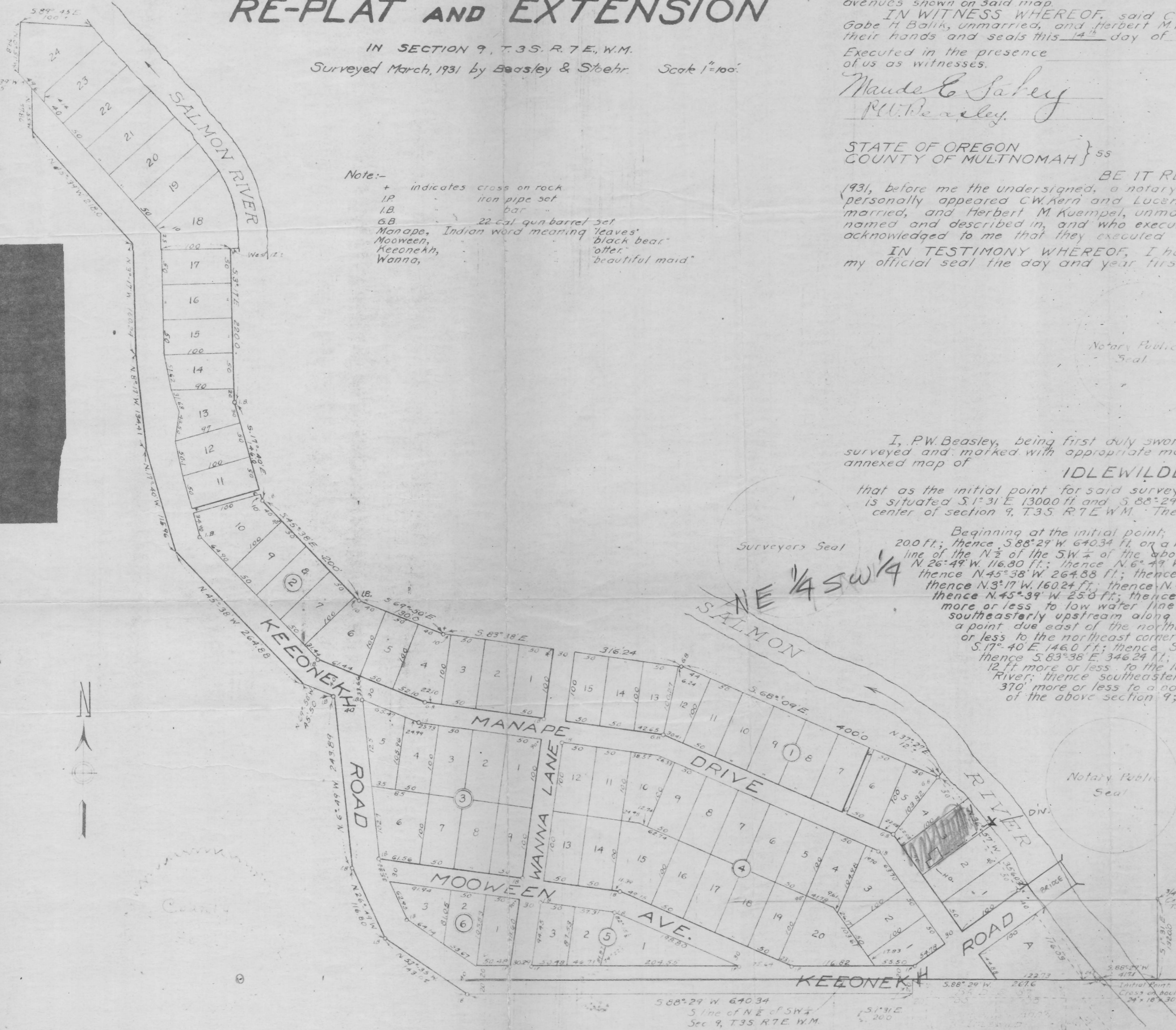

I, P.W. Beasley, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with appropriate monuments the lands represented on the annexed map of

IDLEWILDE (Replat and Extension)

that as the initial point for said survey I marked with a cross a Boulder which is situated S.1°31'E 13000 ft and S.88°29'W 4171 ft from the 34" iron pipe marking the center of section 9, T.3S. R.7E W.M. The property platted is described as follows:-

Beginning at the initial point; thence S.88°29'W 267.6 ft; thence S.1°31'E 200 ft; thence S.88°29'W 640.34 ft on a line 20.0 ft. south of and parallel with the south line of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the above section 9; thence N.57°26'W 143.02 ft; thence N.26°49'W 116.80 ft; thence N.6°49'W 243.89 ft; thence N.69°50'W 45.50 ft; thence N.45°38'W 264.88 ft; thence N.17°40'W 115.96 ft; thence N.8°17'W 134.41 ft; thence N.3°17'W 160.24 ft; thence N.45°39'W 218.0 ft; thence N.1°55'W 57.86 ft; thence N.45°39'W 25.0 ft; thence N.0°51'W 79.8 ft; thence S.89°45'E 100 ft more or less to low water line on westerly side of Salmon River; thence southeasterly upstream along above low water line 400 ft more or less to a point due east of the northeast corner of lot 17; thence west 12 ft more or less to the northeast corner of lot 17; thence S.3°17'E 220.0 ft; thence S.17°40'E 146.0 ft; thence S.45°38'E 200.0 ft; thence S.69°50'E 130.0 ft; thence S.83°38'E 346.24 ft; thence S.68°09'E 400.0 ft; thence N.31°27'E 12 ft more or less to the low water line on the westerly side of Salmon River; thence southeasterly upstream along the above low water line 370 more or less to a point on the south line of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the above section 9; thence S.88°29'W 10 feet more or less to beginning.
