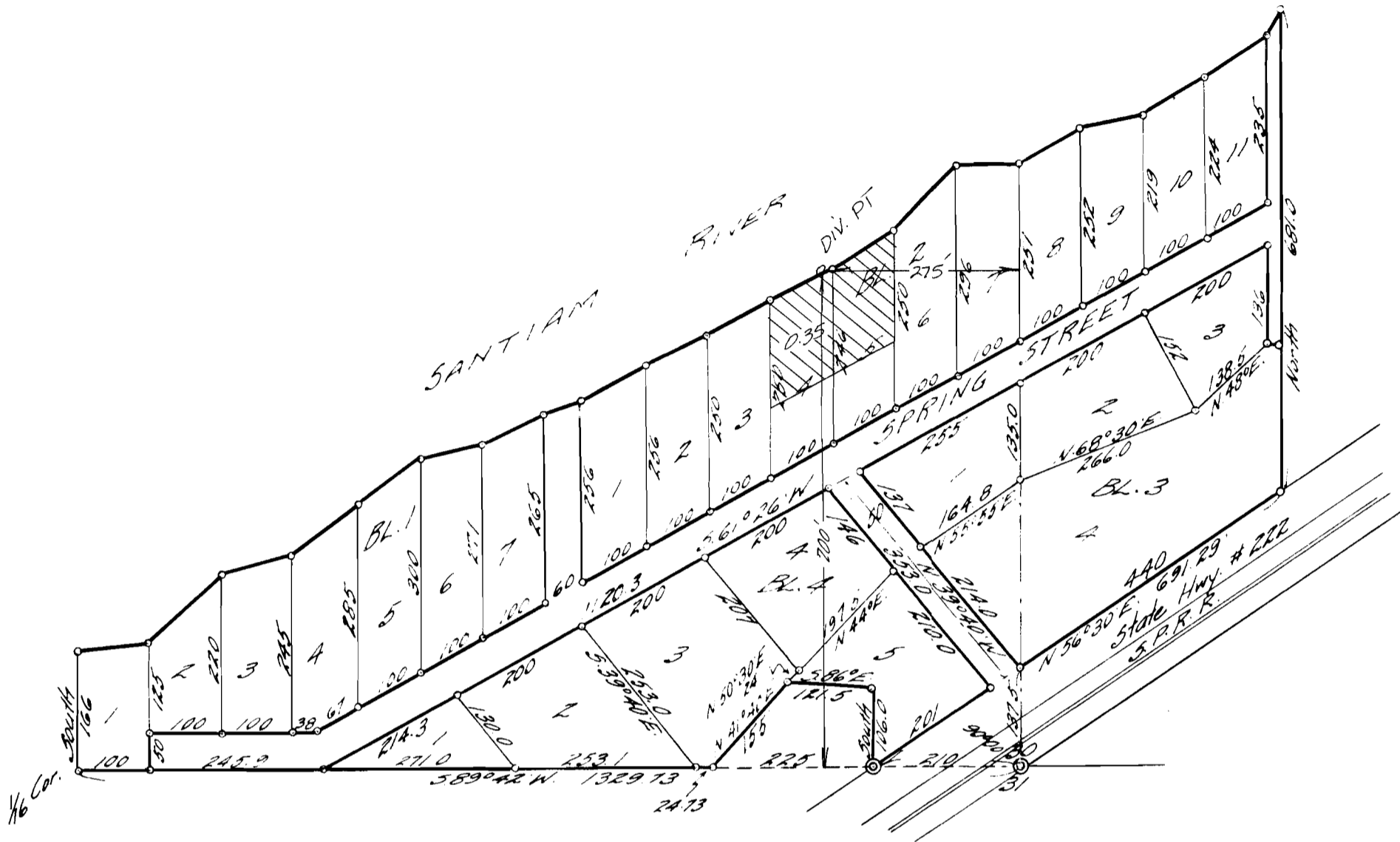


RIVERVIEW ADDITION

That all taxes and assessments against said property have been paid.

I, A.L. Geddes, being first duly sworn say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands as represented on this plat, and that I have placed a monument indicating the initial point of said survey as follows: Set an iron pipe, 2 inches in diameter and 36 inches long, 6 inches below the surface of the ground, said initial point being on the south line of and 589°42'W. 210 feet from the southeast corner of the southwest 1/4 of Section 30 in T.9S, R.3E. of the Will. Mer. in Linn County, Oregon, said point being also on the northwesterly right of way line of State Secondary Highway No. 222. The description of the land included in this plat is as follows: Beginning at said initial point and running thence, N56°30'E. along the northwesterly right of way of said highway 691.29 feet; thence North 691.0 feet to the south bank of the North Santiam River; thence southwesterly along the south bank of said River to a point which is North 166 feet from the southwest corner of the southeast 1/4 of the southwest 1/4 of Section 30, thence South 166 feet to said southwest corner of the southeast 1/4 of the southwest 1/4 of said Section 30; thence N89°42'E. along the south line of said Section 30 894.13 feet to a point 589°42'W. 210 feet from the place of beginning; thence N104°45'E. 155 feet, thence 586°E. 1215 feet to a point North of the place of beginning; thence South 166.0 feet to the place of beginning.
