CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HART BROTHERS

of 604 Second Avenue E., Tillamook, State of Oregon ⁹⁷¹⁴¹, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed lake a tributary of _____ for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18261 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.07 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 1 South, Range 9 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

39.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
32.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
12.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ As projected within N. Daugherty DLC #41
0.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ As projected within N. Daugherty DLC #41

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying South of the Wilson River; also that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and a strip 1 chain wide on the West side of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying North of an unnamed lake all in Section 21, T. 1 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That KEITH GLENN 97876

of Summerville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek and Mill Creek a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18909 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.86 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 & NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 (Willow Creek) NW 1/4 NW 1/4 (Mill Creek), Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Water to be diverted from Willow Creek when available and any deficiency in the available supply in Willow Creek is to be made up by diversion from Mill Creek, providing that the total quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed one-fortieth cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
