

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In your own words tell us what change(s) you want made and the reason for the amendment(s): The permittee, Portland State University, is proposing to amendment Permit G-11831 to enable PSU to supply water for an additional cooling system required to meet the need of PSU's facilities and to further develop the rate of water use authorized by Permit G-11831. The specific changes being requested include (1) correcting the locations of the two authorized points of appropriation (Well 1 and Well 3) stated on the permit, (2) adding Well 1 as an additional point of appropriation for the rate of Well 3 and adding Well 3 as an additional point of appropriation for the rate of Well 1, and (3) adding two additional point(s) of appropriation, SB2 Supply Well 1 and SB2 Supply Well 2, for the rate of Well 1 and Well 3.
