Indicate the name on the current water right. Enter the decree, permit or certificate number, whichever applies. Also enter the priority date, authorized use, source of water, and the county it is located in. If the use and source are in different counties, please indicate.

All applications require evidence of use within the last five years.

Applications for changes in or to point(s) of appropriation require well reports.

Before signing the application be sure you have answered the questions completely and prepared the necessary maps and exhibits. Include a check made out to the Oregon Water Resources Department for the required fees and a completed Land Use Information Form (if required).

I have been asked by James Bauersfeld to review the "Map of Areas of "Non Use" of Water Rights" prepared by Robert Baxter, CWRE dated 9-12-03 and bearing received date Nov. 10, 2003-Water Resources Dept., Salem, Oregon.

I have compared this map to the transfer off map for the Billy L. Coffer Trust originally dated March 20, 2003 and corrected October 20, 2003 prepared by myself for T-9432. I found by overlaying the maps that there is no conflict between the two and none of the water right proposed to be transferred was mapped by Baxter as "Non Use".

I would therefore submit that the transfer can be completed without affecting the "Non Use" process.

Dear Staff:

Based on information supplied by Billy L. Coffer and his agent, James Bauersfeld, I have made amendments to the Baxter map to reflect water rights that Mr. Coffer would concede have been lost by non-use.

These areas include under Certificate No. 75204, in Section 15, T.14S., R.17E., W.M., Crook County, Oregon: SE1/4 SE1/4- 4.6 acres. Under Certificate No. 76365, in Section 15, T.14S., R.17E., W.M., Crook County, Oregon: SE1/4 SE1/4-3.1 acres.

One item of note should be made relative to the Baxter map concerning the alleged nonuse areas. The area shown as 5.6 acres non-use under Certificate No. 75204 located in the NE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 15 would appear to lie above the Staton Ditch. This certificate did not have any water right above or west of the ditch and no water has been applied to those lands. The land is cleared and is dry and has not been claimed as irrigated under the water right certificates noted.

Please review the attached map marked up to locate the affected portions of these water rights bearing date February 20, 2004.


