

To Whom It May Concern:

The Bureau of Land Management would like to submit the following applications in order to lease the identified water rights towards instream flows within the John Day Basin until October 1, 2014. A total of thirteen applications amounting to 7.42 cfs of flow are being proposed to be leased instream in order to restore and protect streamflows within the basin. The rights of downstream water users are being protected by only leasing 50 percent of the water rights. This accounts for the return flows previously available as irrigation water infiltrated and returned to the source.

A transfer application is also being submitted in order to irrigate 3.5 acres of land along Bridge Creek to grow feed for wildlife. The temporary transfer is being proposed to relocate the approved place of use and point of diversion associated with C-13575 downstream to the location of the desired field. Finally, two applications are also being submitted to request the withdrawal of water from the Deschutes River and the John Day River in order to perform annual road maintenance.
