

Additional remarks: Based on our mapping, we find that the place of use under GR-2687 is in a different location relative to the quarter-quarter section boundaries and the DLC lines. This has resulted in revisions to the acres by quarter-quarter section. In addition, the location of the specifications provided below in Table 3 are estimated and subject to change depending on actual conditions encountered in the field. The registered well is more correctly described as 550 feet south and 510 feet east from the NW corner, Section 18. The well construction objective is to construct the well(s) to develop water only from the alluvial aquifer.
