Pursuant to our recent discussions, please find enclosed an application for water right transfer involving the above-referenced water rights, along with a check in the amount of \$2100 for the application fee. This fee includes the \$900 base fee, and then \$400 for each of the three former water rights underlying T-10692. (Arguably, no fee should be paid for the former water rights underlying T-10692 for purposes of this new transfer application, and if so, we would request that the balance of the fee be refunded to the applicant.)

Please also note that while the transfer application calls for certain affidavits of consent, we are providing copies of signed lease amendments by the relevant landowners, which authorize the applicant to make this transfer application. Further, the transfer application calls for evidence of use and supporting documentation. As you know, the applicant has also submitted a COBU for T-10692, which the Department is currently reviewing, and we would ask that the COBU and those materials submitted by the applicant in support of the COBU be included with and incorporated into this transfer application to satisfy this application requirement.

Finally, as you know, we are filing this transfer application in part to avoid the CW-58/T-11066 water from reverting back to the original POU and becoming permanently "married" to the T-10692 water. Again, we understand that the Department has received and is currently reviewing the COBU for T-10692, and that the Department is in a position to accept this water right transfer application so as to preclude the CW-58/T-11066 water from becoming permanently "married" to the T-10692 water. 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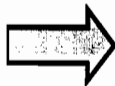
