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

In your own words tell us what change(s) you want made and the reason for the change(s): **Propose to move 46.9 acres of surface water rights from existing place of use to new ground south of the freeway. New ground has an existing groundwater right and is located within a critical groundwater area. Bringing in the primary surface water and diminishing the groundwater to supplemental would save pumping from the depleting basalt aquifer. The transfer of these lands is in conjunction with the submittal of a Conserved Water Allocation application.**

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use. **The water is pumped through 16,000 feet of 54 inch and 48 inch steel pipe to the crossing at Interstate 84. There is a 1,350 horsepower pump for the low lift portion at the river, an 8,600 horsepower pump at the high lift station, and a 600 horsepower booster at the junction with Interstate 84. The system is capable of pumping 110,000 gallons per minute. There is 1,500 feet of six inch portable mainline to distribute to the solid sets. Some of this must be moved to irrigate all of the corners. Also in place is 800 pieces of three inch handline for solid sets, some of which must be moved to complete irrigation. Circles 1 and 2 have 10 inch PVC mainline and circle 3 has a 6 inch mainline. The corners have also been irrigated with traveling big end guns attached to end of mainline.**


