## Authority

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right.

OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

ORS 540.621 establishes the process for the owner of land to which a water right is appurtenant to certify under oath that the water right, or a portion thereof, has been abandoned and to voluntarily request that it be cancelled.

#### Findings of Fact

#### Background

- 1. On June 26, 2009, DESERT SPRINGS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed an application to change the point of appropriation and place of use under Certificate 61097. The Department assigned the application number T-10914.
- 2. On December 17, 2009, the Department issued remaining right Certificate 85977, which supersedes Certificate 61097.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

3. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

Limit/Duty:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of

each year.

4. Transfer Application T-10914 proposes to move the authorized point of appropriation approximately 2 miles from the existing point of appropriation to:

- 6. Notice of the application for transfer was published on July 14, 2009, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. On March 23, 2011, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10914 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of April 25, 2011, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

# Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 8. Water has been used within the last five years prior to the submittal of Transfer Application T-10914 according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 9. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-10914.
- 10. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 11. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

### Partial Cancellation of a Water Right

12. On June 26, 2009, the receiving landowners, Henry and Kareen Queen, submitted an affidavit authorizing the partial cancellation of a portion of Certificate 80952 as follows:

13. The applicant's agent submitted a letter from the Three Sisters Irrigation District that concurs with the partial cancellation of Certificate 80952.

#### **Determination and Proposed Action**

The change in point of appropriation and place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10914 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000 and the abandoned right should be cancelled. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved and the abandoned right will be cancelled.

If Transfer Application T-10914 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The changes in point of appropriation and place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10914 are approved. The portion of the right described by Certificate 80952 that has been abandoned is cancelled.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 85977 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificates 80952 and 85977 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of these rights not affected by this transfer and cancellation.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The water user shall maintain and operate the existing measurement device and shall make such improvements as may be required by the Department.
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 7. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.
- 8. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2012**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

# Notice of Preliminary Determination for Water Right Transfer T-10914

T-10914 filed by Desert Springs Limited Partnership, Attn Eric Vetterlein, 1100 SW Sixth Avenue #1200, Portland, Oregon 97204, proposes a change in point of appropriation and a change in place of use under Certificate 85977. The right allows the use of 0.012 cubic foot per second (priority date March 4, 1980) from a well in Sec. 19, T 15 S, R 11 E, W.M. (Deschutes Basin) for irrigation in Sec. 30, T 15 S, R 11 E, W.M. The applicant proposes to move the point of appropriation approximately 2 miles southeast to within Sec. 32, T 15 S, R 11 E, W.M.) and to change the place of use to within Sec. 32, T 15 S, R 11 E W, W.M. The Water Resources Department has concluded that the proposed transfer appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS Chapter 540 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Any person may file, jointly or severally, with the Department a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the date of final publication of notice in the Department's weekly notice or of this newspaper notice, whichever is later. A protest form and additional information on filing protests may be obtained by calling (503) 986-0883. The last date of newspaper publication is [DATE OF LAST PUBLICATION]. If no protests are filed, the Department will issue a final order consistent with the preliminary determination.
