Reason(s) for amendment/modification(s): The original point of diversion for the City's Columbia River municipal permit is now underwater since the Columbia River was raised after construction of the John Day dam. Thus, the original point of diversion is inaccessible from the river bank and it needs modified so it is located on the new river bank. In addition, the City desires to add two additional diversion locations for river withdrawals. These two additional locations are more easily accessible depending on the method of withdrawal. All proposed points of diversion are located on property owned by the Port of Arlington. The City and Port have an agreement in place for use of these points of diversion. The City of Arlington desires the full permit amount to be available at all proposed points of diversion. The City understands the cumulative use cannot exceed the permit limit of 8.16 CFS. In summary, this Permit Amendment is to modify the original point of diversion that is inaccessible due to the river elevation change and to add two more points of diversion.
