Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. The current system consists of a 75 HP pump located at Kelly Slough. The discharge pipe is 12" PVC lifting 3.8 CFS into the high ditch and 5.5 CFS when the middle ditch is used. There is a ditch along the high side of the irrigated area that is 8 to 10 feet across at the top and 2.5 feet deep. There are 18 inch concrete pipes with slide gates used to distribute the water to the area with water right. The property is flood irrigated through a system of lateral and collection ditches for redistribution.
