





Please note: the location of the existing POA, Well 3, as provided in Table 1 has been re-described to more accurately locate the well. The location provided in Table 1 closely mathes the location of Well 3 as described by the originating permit; however, it appears that the well was mislocated during the final proof survey producing Certificate 82574.
