

Additional remarks: Based on previous discussions with Dorothy Pedersen, we understand that the Department may allow the transfer of the portion of pump manufacturer, we have estimated that rate to be 4.8 gpm or 0.01 cfs. This rate will be adequate to meet our request for nursery use of 2.7 acres. the original use from the ram pump that was dedicated to outdoor use, including irrigation of a "garden". Based on information provided by the ram
