Additional remarks: Based on previous discussions with Dorothy Pedersen, we understand that the Department may allow the transfer of the portion of the original use from the ram pump that was dedicated to outdoor use, including irrigation of a "garden". Based on information provided by the ram pump manufacturer, we have estimated that rate to be 4.8 gpm or 0.01 cfs, which is greater than what the applicant proposes, being 0.006 cfs of water for irrigation use on 0.5 acres, March 1 through October 31.

The previous owner of the property, Ron Schrenk, purchased the property in 1979 from his father and owned it for about 20 years prior to selling it to Jerry Ingle. Ron's father had purchased the land from his father in 1960. The place of use shown on the Amended T-11302 Application Map shows areas historically irrigated for garden use and landscaping at the house, based on Ron Schrenk's historical knowledge. The current owner, Jerry Ingle, has continued to use water for irrigation. Signed statements from Ron Schrenk and Jerry Ingle regarding the historic use of the right for irrigation are attached to this application.

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
