SUBJECT: Water Right Transfer Application T-11343

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-11343. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication and in the Redmond Spokesman newspaper, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the last date of newspaper publication.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.

Authority

Findings of Fact

Background

- On January 12, 2012, the CITY OF REDMOND filed an application for two additional points of appropriation under Certificate 86244. The Department assigned the application number T-11343.
- 2. The right to be transferred is as follows:

- 3. It is noted that Sections 14 and 28 in T 15 S, R 13 E, are served in addition to those Sections authorized in Certificate 86244. This is allowed pursuant to ORS 540.510(3).
- 4. Transfer Application T-11343 proposes two additional points of appropriation: Well 6 being 0.85-1.5 miles east and southeast from Wells 2, 4, and 5; and Well 7 approximately 1.5 miles southeast from Well 1:

- 5. Notice of the application for transfer was published on January 24, 2012, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. On April 3, 2012, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11343 to the applicant, via e-mail. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of May 4, 2012, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 7. Water has been used within the last five years prior to the submittal of Transfer Application T-11343 according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. Pumps and a municipal distribution system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11343.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11343 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-11343 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The additional points of appropriation proposed in application T-11343 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 86244 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificate 86244 is cancelled.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a) Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation.
 - b) The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c) The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 7. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2017**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 8. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.
