Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Water is diverted from the well (Well 4) to irrigation mainlines using a 50-hp turbine pump. The mainlines, which also extend to the east side of Highway 170, consist of more than 1,100 feet of 6-inch-diameter pipe, 1,500 feet of 4-inch-diameter pipe and 600 feet of 3-inch-diameter pipe. Irrigation is conducted using wheel lines, guns and hand lines (most of the area west of Highway 170 is irrigated using hand lines connected to above-ground mainlines). The system operates at about 40 psi. The nozzles are of varying size.

The system capacity is based on WRD's online calculator, which shows that a 50-hp turbine pump lifting water from a pumping water level of 150 feet with an operating pressure of 40 psi can produce 1.40 cfs. The pumping water level is based on the Water Well Report that shows the static water level when the well was drilled was 39 feet and the drawdown was 111 feet when the well was test pumped at 580 gpm (1.29 cfs). Note that this well also is used for irrigation under Certificate 44577, which is part of this transfer and that both rights would allow the diversion of up to 1.19 cfs from the well.
