

Description of Water Delivery System

System capacity: 1.56 cubic feet per second (cfs) **OR**

700 gallons per minute (gpm)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use. **POA number 1 (west well) is a 100 HP Turbine moptor powering a Goulds Pump model number 9RCHC-12 Stages, and POA Number 2 (east well) is a 50 HP Turbine motor powering a Byron Jackson Pump model number 10MQ-L-8 Stages. POA Number 2 pumps to a 50 foot high 30,000 gallon water tower and has a 40 HP booster pump. The water is distributed throughout the golf course through 8", 6", 4", and 2" PVC water lines to Toro 690 series sprinklers. A very detailed description of the system is outlined in the attached May 2011, Irrigation Assessment for Glendoveer Golf course by Larry Rogers Design of Lakewood, Colorado.**
