SUBJECT: Water Right Transfer Application T-11159

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-11159. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the Department's notice.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.

Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

ORS 540.621 establishes the process for the owner of land to which a water right is appurtenant to certify under oath that the water right, or a portion thereof, has been abandoned and to voluntarily request that it be cancelled.

Findings of Fact

Background

- 1. On November 29, 2010, Willow Farms, LLC., filed an application to change the places of use under portions of Certificates 53377, 53379, 75806, 76583, 83341, 83342, 83339 and 83340. The Department assigned the application number T-11159.
- 2. On May 2, 2012, the applicant submitted a new amended application and maps to correctly describe the places of use.
- 3. On October 23, 2012, the applicant submitted affidavits of partial cancellation of the domestic use under Certificates 53377, 53379 and 75806.
- 4. On January 28, 2013, the applicant submitted evidence of stock use under Certificates 53377, 53379 and 75806.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

- 19. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 7, 2010, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 20. On July 20, 2012, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11359 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of August 18, 2012, for the applicant to respond. On September 6, 2012, Bill Porfily, agent for the applicant submitted correspondence via e-mail requesting the Department to proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer. In addition, the applicant has requested additional time in which to complete the transfer in order to comply with ODFW's fish screening requirements. The applicant has requested a completion date of October 1, 2016, which the Department considers reasonable. The completion date has been adjusted to October 1, 2016.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 21. Water has been used within the five-year period prior to submittal of the transfer application according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 22. Diversion structures, ditches, wells, pumps, pipelines and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11159.
- 23. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 24. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

Partial Cancellation of Water Rights

25. On October 23, 2012, affidavits certifying that domestic use under the transferred portions of the following water rights has been abandoned, but stock use and irrigation uses are being retained. Mark Zoller requested cancellation of just the domestic use (with no rate or volume of water to be cancelled). The portions of the rights for which the domestic use will be cancelled are as follows:

Determination and Proposed Action

The changes in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11159 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000 and the abandoned domestic uses under these portions of the rights should be cancelled. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved and the abandoned portions of the rights will be cancelled.

If Transfer Application T-11159 is approved, the final order will include the following:

1. The changes in place of use proposed in application T-11159 are approved and the abandoned domestic portions of the rights are cancelled.

- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 53377, 53379, 75806, 76583, 83339, 83340, 83341 and 83342 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificates 53377, 53379, 75806, 76583, 83339, 83340, 83341 and 83342, are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 4. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion or appropriation. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 5. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 6. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2016**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 7. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
