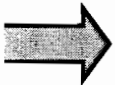

Enclosed herein please find an Application for Permit Amendment for Permit G-15285 held by Durgan Ranch, LLC and the required associated fee of \$2450. The enclosed application requests an existing well, Well 4, be made an authorized point of appropriation for Permit G-15285. Please consider the following information regarding the enclosed application.

Perfection Deadline

The deadline for completion of beneficial use for Permit G-15285 has been extended to October 1, 2013 by final order dated September 23, 2011. Because the new requested well is already constructed, the applicant believes perfection can be accomplished within the existing perfection deadline if approval of the permit amendment is timely received. If the Department requires a second extension of time request be made, the applicant will complete and submit a second extension request without delay.

Location of Authorized Wells 1 – 3

In preparing the enclosed application, the applicant became aware that actual constructed location of authorized Wells 1 – 3 differed slightly from the locations described in the paper permit. Table 1 on page 5 of the enclosed application describes the actual locations of Wells 1 – 3. For the convenience of the Department, below we have outlined the location of the wells (i) as described in the paper permit; and (ii) as actually constructed:


