

The place of use of a portion of the acres being relocated in this application will coincide with the place of use of acres of Certificates 29964 and 80538 being transferred under a transfer application that is accompanying this permit amendment. These acres will be supplemental to the transferred acres associated with Certificates 29964 and 80538.
