THIS PUMP FEEDS GATED PIPE ALONG THE SOUTH IRRIGATED AREA BOUNDARY AND FEEDS A CANAL AND FLOOD DITCHES PARALLELING AND SLIGHTLY SOUTH OF WARM SPRINGS CREEK.**

FROM THE NORTH, LIVE FLOW FROM A COTTONWOOD CREEK DIVERSION FEEDS A CANAL TO SEVERAL USERS. A PORTION OF THAT FLOW DIVERTS FROM THE MAIN CANAL THROUGH 18" PIPE TO PUMP BASIN WITH BOOSTER PUMP JUST INSIDE SUBJECT PROPERTY.
