

Subject: Application Review: T-10608, Peter R. Rawlins (Temporary Transfer)

This transfer application proposes to transfer a portion of an existing surface water right (Cert. 55994) to a well, pursuant to ORS 540.531. The proposed POA is an older shallow dug well with no well log on file, but has been previously determined to be developing an unconfined aquifer in hydraulic connection with Canyon Creek. The well is about 410 feet from Canyon Creek and over 10 miles downstream from the original points of diversion. The downstream distance requires the applicant to have evidence submitted by a licensed geologist that demonstrates that the new point of diversion/appropriation affects the surface water source similarly to the authorized point of diversion. I was previously directed to provide the needed geologist review in support of application T-9340, which was a similar proposal involving this well.

My review indicates that the well is hydraulically connected to the nearby reach of Canyon Creek. Pumping of the well will affect the river 'similarly' to the authorized POD. I am confident that pumping of the well will cause greater than 50 percent stream depletion in less than 10 days. The proposed transfer is also unlikely to cause injury to other ground water users in the area. Potential injury to other surface water rights, if any, should be addressed by the usual watermaster review regarding this point.

Subject: Application Review: T-9340, Peter R. Rawlins (Temporary Transfer)

This transfer application proposes to transfer a portion of an existing surface water right (Cert. 64065) to two wells, pursuant to ORS 540.531. POA #1 is an older dug well with no well log on file and proposed POA #2 is GRAN 867. The wells are about 460 to 470 feet from Canyon Creek and about 10 miles downstream from the original point of diversion. The downstream distance requires the applicant to have evidence submitted by a licensed geologist that demonstrates that the new point of diversion/appropriation affects the surface water source similarly to the authorized point of diversion. I have previously been directed to provide the needed geologist review in support of this application.

My review indicates that the wells are hydraulically connected to the nearby reach of Canyon Creek. They both penetrate an unconfined aquifer despite GRAN 867 being substantially deeper than the old well. Pumping of these wells will affect the river 'similarly' to the authorized POD. I am confident that pumping of the well will cause greater than 50 percent stream depletion in less than 10 days. The proposed transfer is also unlikely to cause injury to other ground water users in the area. Potential injury to other surface water rights, if any, should be addressed by the usual watermaster review regarding this point.
