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# **Description of Water Delivery System**

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System capacity: 1 cubic feet per second (cfs) OR

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Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use. The City of Island City's water system consists of four water supply wells, City Wells No. 1, 2, 3, and 4. The system has two existing steel aboveground water storage reservoirs, a 106,000-gallon reservoir on the north end of the City's Urban Growth Boundary (UGB) adjacent to Well No. 1, and a 750,000-gallon reservoir on the west side of the City's UGB adjacent to Well No. 4, as shown on the Transfer Map. Certificate No. 62005 is a one of the City's Municipal Rights to use the water from City Wells No. 1 and 2.

The water flow from Well No. 1 is connected with a 10-inch diameter PVC water transmission line that leads through a series of valves into the adjacent storage reservoir and then to a booster pump station that supplies a consistent pressure to the City's water distribution system. The water flow from Well No. 2 is connected with a 6-inch diameter PVC water transmission line that leads into the City's water distribution system.

The City of Island City has historically utilized Wells No. 1 and 2 in conjunction with the other wells to meet water demands in the City's water use area. The City is currently restricted in the use of Well No. 1 due to high nitrate levels. All of the City's wells are operated as part of an ondemand telemetry system that can activate the wells based on set points at the water booster pump station. The booster pump station is located at the Well No. 4 and 750,000-gallon reservoir site. The on-demand system is activated through system controls as needed to keep a consistent water level in the reservoir and maintain the water pressure in the distribution system.
