 We propose to transfer the groundwater right for 3.8 acres of farmland to other property owned by the church to provide irrigation water for a ballfield and landscaping around a meetinghouse. We also propose three new Points of Appropriation (two existing wells and one proposed well) to serve the 3.8 irrigated acres at the ballfield and meetinghouse.

Additional remarks: The proposed well (i.e., Well #4) will be slotted, perforated, or screened in productive intervals to be determined in drilling, somewhat similar in that respect to the existing wells #2 and #3.

The new place of use for the transferred right will be a ballfield and landscaping around a meetinghouse. We request that the transferred right allow that the peak flow "or its equivalent in the case of rotation" be allowed so that we do not have to run only a couple of sprinklers at a time almost continually in order to cover the entire irrigated area. Rather, we would like to be able to use the sprinkler system that is in place, but limit the time that it is used, such that the total amount of water used is in complete compliance with the allowed duty.
