Description of Water Delivery System

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use.

Note the irrigation water delivery system serving water for this water right also provides irrigation water for other water rights, Certificates 56158, 64411, and 76052, which are associated with this transfer.

Water is pumped from the south bank of the Columbia River with five turbine pumps totaling 1550 hp. The pumping station is located in the SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 23, T5N, R26E, W.M. From the river pumping station the water flows through a buried 42" pipeline south 1080'+/- to a point where the pipeline bends to the southwest and continues for 1320'+/- and then bends back to a south direction and continues for 2880'+/- to a point where the pipeline bends to the southeast and continues 1000'+/- to a point where it crosses beneath Highway 730 and then continues south another 1760'+/- to a point located along the east line of Section 26 approximately 1320' north of the Southeast Corner of Section 26. The pipeline then continues south 5280'+/- along the east line of Section 35. At the southeast corner of Section 35 the pipeline bends to the southwest and continues 1680'+/- to a point where it crosses the West Extension Canal and enters the northerly edge of the farmland.

At this point there is a 2000 hp pumping station consisting of four short coupled turbine pumps. This is also the beginning of a farm canal which parallels the West Extension Canal and flows in a westerly direction for approximately 1 mile ending in an 800'+/- widen section forming a pond. At the westerly end of the pond there is another pumping station. This one is a 1900 hp pumping station consisting of four short coupled turbine pumps. The pumps at these two pumping stations deliver water south to the farmland through a buried pipe distribution system consisting of steel and PVC pipes ranging in size from 30" to 4" in diameter. The layout of the on farm pipe distribution system is shown on the transfer maps. For the most part circular irrigation machine are now being used irrigate the farmland.

Water is pumped from the south bank of the Columbia River with five turbine pumps totaling 1550 hp. The pumping station is located in the SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 23, T5N, R26E, W.M. From the river pumping station the water flows through a buried 42" pipeline south 1080'+/- to a point where the pipeline bends to the southwest and continues for 1320'+/- and then bends back to a south direction and continues for 2880'+/- to a point where the pipeline bends to the southeast and continues 1000'+/- to a point where it crosses beneath Highway 730 and then continues south another 1760'+/- to a point located along the east line of Section 26 approximately 1320' north of the Southeast Corner of Section 26. The pipeline then continues south 5280'+/- along the east line of Section 35. At the southeast corner of Section 35 the pipeline bends to the southwest and continues 1680'+/- to a point where it crosses the West Extension Canal and enters the northerly edge of the farmland.

At this point there is a 2000 hp pumping station consisting of four short coupled turbine pumps. This is also the beginning of a farm canal which parallels the West Extension Canal and flows in a westerly direction for approximately 1 mile ending in an 800'+/- widen section forming a pond. At the westerly end of the pond there is another pumping station. This one is a 1900 hp pumping station consisting of four short coupled turbine pumps. The pumps at these two pumping stations deliver water south to the farmland through a buried pipe distribution system consisting of steel and PVC pipes ranging in size from 30" to 4" in diameter. The layout of the on farm pipe distribution system is shown on the transfer maps. For the most part circular irrigation machine are now being used irrigate the farmland.

The portion of water right Certificate 87073 which is involved in this transfer involves a small portion of the irrigated acres on a large farm. The water is pumped from the Columbia River at the River Pumping Station. The River Pumping Station is located on the south bank of the Columbia River in Section 8, T5N, R30E, WM and consists of an 11,500 horsepower (hp) pumping station that pumps water from the Columbia River approximately 24,000 feet south to the northerly boundary of the Hutterite Stanfield Farm where Booster Pumping Station No. 1 is located. Booster Pumping Station No. 1 is a 4,800 hp booster pumping station. It boosts the pressure and pumps the water in a southeast direction through a buried piping network. There are two parallel 40" pipelines extending to the southeast from Booster No. 1.

Approximately 3970' southeast of Booster Pumping Station No. 1 there is a point where a 24" pipeline connects to one of the 40" pipelines. This 24" pipeline extends southwest 550'+/- to a cluster point where it reduces to 20" and continues southwest 4330'+/- to another cluster point. From this cluster point there is an 8" pipeline that extends northerly 1670'+/- to the pivot point of a part circle circular irrigation machine which irrigates ground located in Sections 5, 6, and 7, T4N, R30E, W. M. which is associated with this transfer.

Approximately 9110' southeast of Booster Pumping Station No. 1 there is a 1400 hp booster pumping station, Booster No. 2. From this booster pumping station there is a 14" pipeline that extends in a northeasterly direction 3000'+/- to a cluster point. From this cluster point there is a 10" pipeline that continues 1310'+/- northeast to the pivot point of the circular irrigation machine that irrigates ground in Section 4, T4N, R30E, W. M. which is associated with this transfer.

From Booster Pump No. 2 there is a 26" pipeline that extends southeast 5420'+/- to a cluster point located slightly north of the center of Section 16. At this cluster point the 26" pipeline reduces to a 22" pipeline which continues southeast 5430'+/- to another cluster point located in the NW1/4 NW1/4 of Section 22. At this cluster point the pipeline reduces to 16" and continues southeast 2330'+/- to another cluster point. From this cluster point there is a 10" pipeline that extends in a northeasterly direction 1240'+/- to the pivot point of a circular irrigation machine that irrigates ground located in Section 22, T4N, R30E, W. M. which is associated with this transfer.
