2.3	Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on September 30, 2012.
2.4	Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see Section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.
	~III~ Other Information
3.1	Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this application is true, correct and

complete. If after the lease order is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease order may be modified or terminated. The lease only exercises the water rights being leased, for the term of the lease. It shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease. 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Lease. Lessor(s) and Lessee(s) agree to lease the water rights listed in Section(s) 1.5 for 3.2 instream use for the term of this lease through Lessee to the Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077. 3.3 **Precedent.** If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077 a new injury review shall be required, and a prior lease shall not set a precedent for the amount of water to be leased or transferred instream. Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the water right holder agrees to 3.4 suspend use of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights. 3.5 Termination provision. For multiyear leases, the Lessor(s) shall have the option of terminating the lease each year with written notice to the Department. The lease may be terminated at any time during the calendar year. However, if the termination request is received less then 30days prior to the period of allowed instream use or after the period of allowed use has begun for the water right(s) being leased, water may not be used under the right(s) leased until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur. The Department may also require: • Written notice to the Department with original signatures; • Consent by all parties to the lease; and/or Written notice to the Watermaster's office. For multiyear leases, the lessor shall not have the option of terminating the lease, without consent by all parties to the lease. Modification to prevent injury. Allocation of water to the instream use described in 3.6 Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source. If injury is found after this lease is signed, the lease may be modified or terminated to prevent injury. 3.7 Fees. Pursuant to ORS 536.050, the following fee is included: \$200 for an application with four or more landowners or four or more water rights. \boxtimes \$100 for all other applications. 



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, that HERMAN A. DITTMAN

of Route 4, Box 32, Sherwood

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Cummings Ditch and Unnamed Ditches trib. to Rock Cr.

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree c, the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.231 c.f.s.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10.5 acres in NWbSWL 8.0 acres in SWLSWL Section 21 T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point 550 feet north and 7.8 feet east of the southwest corner of Sec. 21, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; thence north 1886.0 feet to the south r/w line of the old County Highway; thence along said r/w line N. 75° 36' E. 259.42 feet; thence N. 51° 10' E. 56.1 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 119.0 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 69° 44' E. 48.79 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 1876.43 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89° 12' W. 456.75 feet to the point of beginning.



And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.


