Explanation of the purpose of the transfer from Part 4 of 5

We need to transfer 4.5 acres of our water right (certificate 660082) to "square up" an adjacent field to enable me to fully utilize a wheel line in said field. The new area to be irrigated is a rectangle measuring 367 x 531 feet for a total of 4.473 acres. This rectangle lies mostly in the SW ¼ of the NW ¼ of section 22 but also partially in the SW ¼ of the NE ¼ of section 22. 3.9 acres of this transfer will come from the Nw ¼ of the NW ¼ of section 22. .6 acres of the transfer will come off the western side of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of section 22.

Answer to question on top of part 5 of 5, page 6 of 8

A 75 HP electric motor pumps water up an intake tube from the Grande Ronde River at POD No. 1 and into a 10 inch mainline that runs from the pump up the east side of an old oxbow of the river then around the southern end of said ox bow, then due east to terminate at the NW corner of NW ¼ of SW ¼ of section 22. There is also a buried 8 inch lateral main line that runs from the main line at the SE corner of the oxbow to the top of the "22" on the map. The lateral terminates just west of a yard where pipe and equipment are stored and where a hay shed is located. This main line and lateral has risers every 80 feet and supply water to 4 different wheel lines. The pasture in the NW ¼ of the NW1/4 and the NE ¼ of NW ¼ of section 22 is watered by 4 inch handline that is stored in the above described equipment yard when not laid out in the pasture.
