do hereby make application for an extension of time within which to complete a change in:

of water under the terms of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on **December 23, 2002**, approving Transfer **T-9230**, in the name of **City of Mount Angel**,  
for use of water for municipal purposes by the City of Mount Angel

THE FOLLOWING HAS BEEN accomplished toward completion of the change within the time allowed, which expired on October 1, 2008:

**The new point of appropriation for Certificate 32220 and the additional point of appropriation for Certificate 56259, Well 7, has been constructed and brought into service to supply groundwater for municipal use by the City under T-9230. The original point of appropriation for Certificate 32220, Well 5, has continued to be used for to supply groundwater for municipal use by the City under T-9230.**


TO FULLY COMPLETE the change, it will be necessary to accomplish the following:

**The production rate of Well 5 has declined since the date the transfer application was filed. The rehabilitation of Well 5 needs to be evaluated in order to determine whether Well 5 can be rehabilitated to restore the production capacity of the well. Both Well 5 and Well 7 are needed in order to use the full rate of groundwater use authorized under T-9230.**

I AM UNABLE TO COMPLETE the change under the terms of the order, within the time allowed, because:

**T-9230 supplies two of the City's three primary water supply wells, and provides approximately half of the water supply needed by the City. As a result of the decline in production rate of Well 5, the City does not have sufficient well production capacity with Well 7 alone to use the full rate of groundwater use authorized under T-9230. Because groundwater is the sole source of water supply for the City, and because of the likely inability to obtain additional water rights in the future due to the City being located in a designated groundwater limited area, the City needs to maintain the full rate of T-9230 to meet future water demand needs of the City. Additional time is needed to (1) evaluate the condition of Well 5 and the ability to rehabilitate the well to restore production capacity, (2) add the rehabilitation of Well 5 to the City's capital improvement schedule, and (3) to implement the rehabilitation (if rehabilitation is possible).**

And request that the time for completion be extended to October 1, 2020.
