Re: International Paper, Albany, Oregon in stream Lease Application submittals.

Please find enclosed three applications for In stream Lease's, one each, for three water rights pertaining to the International Paper (IP) property in Albany, Oregon along with a check in the amount of \$300.00 for the applications fees.

Certificates no.'s 54268, 85736, and Transfer 7526 are intertwined. All of these rights were at one time for Willamette Industries and 3 manufacturing facilities located on the overall contiguous land.
