- 2.3 Term of lease. This lease shall terminate on October 31, 2009.
- 2.4 Flow protection. The Trustee will regulate use of water from the source, subject to prior appropriation and the agency enforcement guidance, to assure the water is delivered to the point of diversion, and through the reach past junior downstream users, so long as flow is sufficient to meet the demand under priority date of the new instream use (see section 2.2). As part of regulation activities the watermaster or a designee has access to the point of diversion and place of use for the water rights involved in this lease. No party is required to continuously measure the flow of the waterway described in Section 2.2.

~III~ Other Information

- 3.1 Accuracy. The Undersigned Lessor/s, Lessee and Trustee declare that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this lease is true, correct and complete. If after the lease is signed, any information is determined to be false, the lease may be modified or terminated. This lease only exercises the water rights being leased; for the term of the lease; it shall not be construed to overcome any claim that the water right may otherwise be subject to forfeiture for nonuse pursuant to ORS 540.610 during the period of time prior to the execution of the lease.
- 3.2 Lease. All Lessors agree to lease the water rights listed in 1.4 for instream use for the term of this Agreement through Lessee to Trustee, the Oregon Water Resources Department, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.348(2) and OAR 690-077-0077.
- **Precedent.** If a right which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again or transferred to an instream use under ORS 537.348 and OAR 690-077-0070 or OAR 690-

Suspension of original use. During the period of the lease, the owner agrees to suspend use 3.4 of water allowed under the subject water rights and under any water right that is supplemental to the subject water rights. In the event that a supplemental water right is not part of this lease, it may be subject to forfeiture. 3.5 Termination provision. For multiyear leases, lessor shall have the option of terminating the lease each year, prior to the lease being exercised (July 14), with 30 day written notice to the Department. For multiyear leases, lessor shall not have the option of terminating the lease each year, prior to the lease being exercised, with written notice to the Department. Modification to prevent injury. Allocation of water to the instream use described in 3.6 Section 2.2 during the term of this lease is not reasonably expected to cause injury to other rights to use water from the same source. If injury is found after this lease is signed, the lease may be modified or terminated to prevent injury. Fees. Effective October 1, 2003, pursuant to ORS 536.050 (1)(v) (2003 SB 820), the 3.7 following fee is included: \$200 for an application with four or more landowners or four or more water rights. \$100 for all other applications. 

Tax Lot Map of Lessor's Property

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


Attachment 2 Short - Term Water Right Lease Agreement Leased Right Map



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ADOLEH OLSON

of Box 197, Umpqua , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 22.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28061 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 ($NW_{+}^{1}SW_{+}^{1}$), Section 21, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres Lot 6 (NE SE)
Section 20

Certificate of water right issued to Adolph Olson and recorded at page 32074, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 23.9 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 1.1 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer entered August 15, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Adolph Olson.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.


