



Dear Kelly,

The City of Hillsboro is submitting the enclosed Application for Water Right Instream Lease for Certificate 23068. The City requests that Certificate 23068 has an instream rate of 0.452 cfs and an instream use period of June 23 through September 30 from the point of diversion to the mouth of the Tualatin River.

The subject place of use spans tax lots owned by the City of Hillsboro and jointly by the City of Hillsboro and Metro. The City of Hillsboro manages the water rights on the subject place of use. In addition, the City of Hillsboro and Metro recently sold a small portion of the subject place of use in the NESW Quarter Quarter and SESW Quarter Quarter of Section 35, but the City of Hillsboro and Metro retained the water rights, as shown in Attachment 2 in the application.

The City also has enclosed a check to cover the required fee of \$250 for an instream lease application.
