*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. Blank 5b would be 0 and Line 5 would then also become 0).

Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: **Place of Use (POU) Transfer**

The recording of Tract 1314 Pine Ridge Ranches divided lots into 5 acre plots. Some of these lots lie along the edge of the Williamson River. Under the original water right, Certificate 65750, the water right does not extend to the river's edge. The owner of Tract 1314 Lots 16 & 17 has constructed a homesite near the water's edge and would like to use the water right to irrigate the portion of the lot which lies outside of the original water right. They would like to transfer an equal portion of their water right within the parameters of their lots to a portion that is next to the river where their homesite lies so they can irrigate their lawn and pasture.

Point of Diversion (POD) Transfer

The owner of Lots 16 & 17, Tract 1314 Pine Ridge Ranches is requesting a proposed POD at the river's edge on Lot 16 so they can be more efficient in watering their properties. Currently they have to coordinate with a second party to operate a 30 HP pump, located at the authorized POD, and fill/pressurize the entire system of 9900± feet of 6" to 14" buried piping in order to supply irrigation water to their property. If the proposed POD at Lot 16 is granted, they will have the ability to irrigate their two lots without coordinating with a second party and wasting water by filling/pressurizing lengthy and large diameter water conveyance piping. The proposed POD currently has a 1 1/2 HP pump which will conserve energy. Without the need to fill/pressurize lengthy and large diameter water conveyance piping, only the amount of water needed to irrigate Lots 16 & 17 will be drawn from the Williamson River. The use of the proposed POD at their lot will save time, conserve energy and water, as well as eliminate second party requirements.

Description of Water Delivery System

System capacity: 3.17 cubic feet per second (cfs)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use.

The water conveyance system begins at the authorized POD "From" which has a 30 HP pump able to deliver approximately 1400 gpm from the Williamson River. From the pump, water is conveyed via a 14" buried pipe extending easterly 890± feet to a tee. At the tee a 12" buried pipe extends southerly 1480± feet to a valve. From the valve a 10" buried pipe extends southerly 1070± feet to the subject property (Lots 16 & 17, Tract 1314 Pine Ridge Ranches, Tax Lots 2100 & 2200). A 6" buried pipe then extends westerly 40± feet across a gravel road to a 3" above-ground connection point where the lot owner connects piping and sprinklers to irrigate their property.
