The landowner has addressed this in the application by requesting "reinstatement of water rights". I believe the water to fulfill the rights was available but that the infrastructure and access to the POD to effectivly use the water was not, therefor, 540.610(j) does not apply. I am available to conduct further research to verify non-use if proof beyond landowner acknowledgement is necessary.
